
# Explore Vijayawada Top 8 attractions

An iconic bridge spanning the Krishna River, Prakasam Barrage is a marvel of engineering and a symbol of Vijayawada's heritage. By day, it facilitates irrigation and transportation; by night, it transforms into a luminous spectacle, making it perfect for evening strolls and photography. Notably, in 2023, it was recognized asa World Heritage Irrigation Structure by the International Commission on Irrigation and Drainage (ICID), highlighting its historical significance and contribution to irrigation in the region.



**PRAKASAM BARRAGE** 



Situated atop the auspicious hill of Mangalagiri, this ancient Vaishnavite temple is one of the eight sacred Mahakshetras of Lord Vishnu in India.
